Review/Approval of 2019 Annual Meeting Minutes – David Massey

Review/Approval of 2019 Financials - Miriam Hopkins

1. Balance of the Checking account is \$46,569.41 and the Perpetual account is \$156,221.07. Expenses from the checking account are \$7,230.48 and insurance \$500 for a total of \$7,730.48.
2. Total income for the year 2019 was down. Equipment repairs and purchases were made, allowing MCA to make a lot of improvements within the cemetery. Last year's contribution of \$10,000 by Sid Davis was helpful.
3. Miriam provided Fiscal Year-to-Date (YTD) balances of checking account, perpetual funds, and total assets, as listed on the 2019 report.
4. Motion to accept Financials: Tommy Lee moved to accept and approve Financials and seconded by Betty Mangum. Approved by all members present.
